

Travelling through Céret means discovering a city marked by the history and imprint of Catalan culture and traditions echoing with a heritage preserved through the centuries.


Céret has always been a source of inspiration for the greatest masters of Modern Art, as well as the greatest artists of Contemporary Art. You can find their works at the Modern Art Museum, a museum of European scale.

Céret takes advantage of its wonderful location between sea and mountain to offer Cérétans and tourists a multitude of outdoor activities. Hiking and mountain biking adapted to all levels, including

paragliding on the tops of Céret, bungee jumping or canyoning in the Canyon du Gourg des Anelles.



The hillsides of the Ventous, held on by old dry stone walls, with an exceptional exposure, were once mainly dedicated to the cultivation of cherries (the first cherries of France because of its earliness) and the vineyards. For many generations, Ceretan families have cultivated on this steep terrain which is difficult to exploit. During this walk, a walk on the gentle slopes without major difficulty, a heady fragrance will flare your nostrils.

6 Le Ventous





Departure: Place des tilleuls in Ceret, above the Tins Car park.

O min: Follow the rue des Evadés, then the road to Fontfrède, before reaching rue Edmond Brazès, at the top of which there is a path off to the right.

10 min: Follow the trail that begins near and borders orchards, then sneaks in to the shade along a stone wall. The trail, which is earth and stones, crosses a small stream and climbs gently to a junction. There you can enjoy the view towards cherry orchards and the Canigó.

20 min: At the intersection, take the opposite paved road. After 400 meters, take the small dirt path on the left in the direction Col de Boussells.

35 min : At the Col de Bossells, turn immediately right between two houses. Remain on this road that becomes a track. Enjoy views of the town of Ceret and Ceret heights.

45 min: At the first fork, between Canigó (on the left) and view of Ceret and Alberes (on the right) take the road to the right (opposite). From there, keep right on all of the following forks.

1h00: After a few steps made in wooden log, follow the fence of a private property. Go down the steps and cross the canal, continue until you cross the road. Then turn left.

1h10: At the roundabout, go to the opposite side, rue Salvador Allender right at the intersection with Avenue François Mitterrand. Cross the road and take a path down to the left and cross a small stream before reaching the Place de la Republique. You are just beside the Tins car park.
